New Desire has enjoyed consistent chart success since the release of their first single, *Heaven is So Beautiful*, in 1998. Their latest projects have been consistently successful through internet mediums such as iTunes, amazon.com, Spotify, Rhapsody and more.

In 1991, Brenda branched out into women's ministry. Over the past twenty-two years of ministry, she has authored nine books including her autobiography, *Seized For His Glory*, and her newest release, *A New Desire*, which was published by CrossBooks, a division of LifeWay. The publication of these books opened many new avenues of ministry, including book-signing appearances at the Christian Bookseller's Association and interviews on Life Today with James and Betty Robison and Daystar with Marcus & Joni Lamb. New Desire has also appeared on Atlanta Live, Dove Broadcasting Network in South Carolina, and TBN. Dr. Robinson has developed five Bible Study classes based on her books, which she personally teaches to women's groups throughout the country. Brenda received her Doctorate of Divinity from Covington Theological Seminary (Rossville, GA) in 2002 and her Bachelors of Theology in 2013.

Today, New Desire is more than just music. Dan has shared this message all across the United States and abroad, "We are not singers that minister, but we are ministers that sing." Singing truly just opens the door for New Desire to come in a minister to new groups of people.
